RULES OF THE OPEN ALL BREED SHOWS:

1. CLASSIFICATIONS: ATR = Adult Amateurs 19 & over; JTR = Youths 18 & under; OPEN: All riders including Amateurs, Youths and Professionals.
2. NOVICE HORSE: Has never won more than 3 blue ribbons in this division at any show.
3. NOVICE RIDER: AMATEURS ONLY! Has never won more than 3 blue ribbons in this division in any show.
4. AMATEUR: One who does not accept remuneration for training, showing or giving lessons. 19 years old and older.
5. PROFESSIONALS: May show in OPEN CLASSES with a number. May show in other Adult classes with number turned over.
6. CLASSES: Classes of less than 3 entries may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the SHOW SECRETARY.
7. ENTRIES: NO REFUNDS. Entries must be made 3 classes in advance or enter at the gate with an open check.
8. GATE: One (1) minute gate will be enforced. Tack changes must be requested before the class.
9. RIBBONS: Rosette Ribbons awarded to 1st through 6th Place.
10. LEADLINE: Blue ribbons to each participant. This is not a judged class.
11. WALK/TROT/JOG: Anyone participating in these classes MAY compete in all performance classes.
12. MINIS: Over-sized minis (34-38") ARE permitted in mini classes.
13. WEANLINGS: Must show in a minimum of 2 shows to qualify for year-end awards (applies to weanling halter only!)
*NEW - 4 SALE CLASS: (Not judged) must follow all rules as to equipment and attire.
14. SHOW GRAND CHAMPION: Includes all 1st place mares, geldings and stallions in classes 3 through 12.

EQUIPMENT, TACK AND CLOTHING

1. HUNTSEAT: Huntseat attire. Jackets are optional. Boots and hats required.
2. SADDLESEAT: Saddleseat attire. Jackets are optional. Boots and hats required.
3. WESTERN: Western attire. Hats and boots are required. Chaps optional. When riding with bosals or snaffles, two hands may be used. Long sleeved shirts are required.
4. TRAINING DEVICES: Running martingales, cavessons and snaffles are permitted. No wraps, draw reins, splint boots or German martingales. This applies to schooling horses too! No martingales with a curb bit! This includes schooling...no exceptions.

AWARDS

YOU MAY ONLY CHOOSE ONE CATEGORY

1. DAILY HIGH POINTS: Consists of the greatest number of points accumulated during the show (see categories). Ties will be broken by the highest placings first, and secondly by the number classes entered. You MUST enter at least 4 classes to be eligible. These can include Novice horse or rider or Walk/Jog/Trot classes. YOU MUST DECLARE YOUR HIGH POINT DIVISION ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.
2. TRAINER OF THE YEAR: Each student will be given one point for each class entered for their trainer. Points will be accumulated through the year. Year-end awards will be presented at the year end Show Circuit Banquet.
3. YEAR-END HIGH POINTS: Consists of the greatest number of points accumulated per show (See categories). Ties will be broken by the highest placings first, and secondly by the number classes entered. Points are tallied as follows: (1) Same horse and rider combination in Youth and Amateur qualifying classes; (2) Horse and Owner of Horse in Open qualifying classes.
4. YEAR-END AWARDS: To qualify for Year-End High Point Awards, you must be a paid member in good standing of the Show Circuit Association. Your points will accumulate when you join, not before. You must show in a minimum of 4 shows in 2008 to qualify.

Youth (13 & under): JTR Showmanship, Western Pleasure and Stockseat Equitation, Huntseat Pleasure and Equitation, Saddleseat Pleasure and Equitation
Youth (14-18): JTR Showmanship, Western Pleasure and Stockseat Equitation, Huntseat Pleasure and Equitation, Saddleseat Pleasure and Equitation
Amateur (19 & over): ATR Showmanship, Western Pleasure and Stockseat Equitation, Huntseat Pleasure and Equitation, Saddleseat Pleasure and Equitation
Open: Open Showmanship, Western Pleasure and Stockseat Equitation, Huntseat Pleasure and Equitation, Saddleseat Pleasure and Equitation
